Meeting called to order @ 6:31pm by President Townsend.

Those present were: Jack Townsend, Steve Jordan, Denny Kuhl, Greg Thoren, John & Haylen Scott and Susan Schamberger

Approval of the January 17, 2018 board minutes: Motion by Jordan and seconded by Townsend to accept as written with no additions or corrections needed. Motion carried with all voting yes.

Approval of the Treasurer's Report Financial Statements for January 2018: Motion made by Townsend and seconded by Schamberger to accept as presented with no additions or corrections needed. Motion passed with all voting yes.

Manager's Report: Denny Young not present

He asked if the park district had a list of projects that we were currently hoping to get completed or even funded with outside help. Mr. Scott stated the wooden train in the park had been an Eagle Scout project many years back. The train is also in need of some repairs at this present time he noted. Another idea was the old light posts in the park being restored to working order. Susan Schamberger said that the board was aware that Denny Young does have a wish list of items and the light posts are on the list. Bleachers are also a concern the park district has. Denny and John should discuss ideas.

Old Business:

Decker Aqua Sod Acres – Greg Thoren stated he has concerns that this park is just going to cost the township tax payer's unlimited dollars without any way to recoup its costs for maintenance and upgrades. The board did agree there will be initial costs to get the park furnished with all necessary bathrooms and shelter areas. The park commissioners are looking into ideas and are open for suggestions to help cover costs to the district.
