
ATTENTION STOCKTON SEWER CUSTOMERS

Beginning in April 2021, the Village will be completing a waste water treatment improvements project. The project will be completed in two phases. Phase 1 entails the construction of the Sludge Storage Building, Flow Equalization Lagoons, Brewster Cheese Pump Station, Control Building, and Force Main, Interceptor Sewer, Watermain Extension, and associated appurtenances. Phase 1 is estimated to cost roughly \$7,000,000.00 and is being financed with 30-year 1% loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Water Pollution Control Loan Program (WPCLP). The Village will also be securing \$2,882,173.95 in principal loan forgiveness from IEPA. The final loan amount the Village will have to pay back is estimated at \$4,195,000.00.

The Water Pollution Control State Revolving Fund (SRF) is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). A portion of the IEPA money to fund these types of projects comes from the US Environmental Protection Agency. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities with the resources to build, maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
