## VILLAGE OF STOCKTON DOWNTOWN SIDEWALKS & STREETScape PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

**WHEN:** Tuesday September 13, 2022: 5:00 to 7:00pm (Presentations at 5:15 & 6:15)

**WHERE:** Stockton Village Hall, 155 West Front Avenue

**NOTICE:** The Village of Stockton will hold an Informational Meeting concerning the downtown sidewalk and streetscape improvements along Main Street (IL 78) from Queen Ave. to Benton Ave. and along Front Street from N. Hudson St. to N. Pearl St. The project will consist of constructing ADA compliant sidewalks, curb ramps, cross walks, and ramps into businesses. Other project improvements will include new curb and gutter, storm sewer, decorative concrete terraces/borders, and decorative street lighting. Property specific items may be discussed on an individual basis with each property owner affected at this meeting.

The informational meeting will be held at Village Hall at the time, date, and location listed above. All persons interested in this project are invited to attend this meeting.

Representatives of the Village of Stockton and MSA Professional Services will present an overview of the project and will be available before and after the 5:15pm & 6:15pm presentations, to discuss the project on an individual basis. Representatives will answer individual questions and record comments offered by those in attendance. Verbatim comments will not be recorded. The presentation will address topics such as the need for the project, proposed design concepts, right-of-way acquisition, schedule, and construction expectations. Preliminary plans and exhibits, will be available for inspection and viewing during the entire time.

The meeting will be conducted on an informal basis and the public may attend on a drop-in basis. If special accommodations are required, please contact Village Hall at (815) 947-2515. The meeting room is accessible to persons with a disability.
